Adam passed away peacefully of natural causes at Oakmont Nursing Home in Lake Mary, Florida. Adam was 86 years old.

Adam was born on September 5th, 1929 in the town of Kernei (Krnjaja) , Yugoslavia to Kaspar Rottinger and Elizabeth Bohnert.

Post World War II was a difficult time in Yugoslavia and the Rottinger family was forced to flee to Austria. That is where Adam learned his skills as a wood worker and cabinet maker. In search of a better life, Adam, his parents and siblings immigrated to the U.S. in 1952.

Adam was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1954 where he served his tour of duty in France. He was honorably discharged in 1956.

After working at Ford for a short time, he went to work in his chosen field as a cabinet maker and later, a cabinet shop owner with his brother Jacob and brother-in-law Ron Galauner. In 1981 Adam and his family moved to Stuart, Florida where he started another cabinet business.
