



## Agnes Arasimowicz Reynolds

November 13, 1918 - March 7, 2019

Agnes Arasimowicz Reynolds, 100, of Apopka, FL., passed away after a brief illness at home on March 7, 2019.

The wife of the late Eugene F. Reynolds, Sr., they were married nearly 53 years at the time of his death in 1992.
