Andrew Edward Chontos, 88, died peacefully at the Hospice of the Comforter in Altamonte Springs, Florida on November 21, 2014. He was born and raised in McKeesport, Pennsylvania the first child of Andrew Thomas Chontos and Margaret Kovacs Chontos on September 3, 1926. He was predeceased by a sister Dolores Chontos Reskovac, and his beloved wife of 61 years, Dorothy Belak Chontos, with whom he had three children, Andrea Chontos Peters (husband Conrad), Lori Anne Chontos, his devoted caregiver and Terry Joseph Chontos (wife Deborah). Mr. Chontos was a member of the Telephone Pioneers Chapter 126, Corpus Christi Parish of McKeesport, and Saint Margaret Mary Church of Winter Park. He also volunteered as an advisor for Junior Achievement.

Sadie, as he was known to many, was a dedicated and loving family man, with a unique sense of humor. He never met a stranger and was admired by his

neighbors on Circle Drive in White Oak, PA. A private service is scheduled for Tuesday, November 25 in Central Florida, with interment at Sacred Heart Cemetery in Port Vue, PA in late spring.
