



## Dr. Andrew J. Judd

July 16, 1946 - April 14, 2022

Dr. Andrew J. Judd of Oviedo, Florida passed away unexpectedly at the age of 75 on Thursday, April 14, 2022, while visiting family in Sebastian, Florida.

Andy was born in Ohio to Donald S. and Margaret Judd. After an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army, he earned undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Washington, Seattle, and received his PhD in accounting from the University of Florida.

Andy was a professor for 26 years at the University of Central Florida and director of the Kenneth G. Dixon School of Accounting for 11 of those years. As an educator and mentor, he was loved and admired by his students and his fellow UCF faculty.
