Angelina (Ange) Rapasardi Newell passed away peacefully on Monday, April 14, 2025. She was 96.

Angelina was born in Glenwood Springs, Colorado, and spent her childhood working with her parents and siblings on the family's sheep ranch in Western Colorado.

Angelina left home at 18 and worked as a waitress, traveling across the United States with her sister Mary. She met and married her husband, Airman Peter (Pete) Newell, in 1951 and quickly grew to love life as a military wife.
