

## Mr. Anthony Sass

February 8, 1935 - August 18, 2013

Anthony Sass (Apu) passed away on Sunday, August 18th at the age of 78. He was born on February 8, 1935 in Magyargencs, Hungary and immigrated to the United States in 1956. Upon arriving to the United States he worked as a short order cook at a restaurant, owned and operated a laundromat, and was also a member of the crew that constructed the Verrazano-Narrows Bridge. He spent over 20 years working as Chief Engineer at the Krauszer's Dairy plant in Edison, N.J. After moving to Central Florida in 1982, he worked for T G Lee Dairy in Orlando. For over 30 years Tony and his son Laszlo owned and operated a home improvement business serving the Central Florida area. He was a hardworking, generous and very devoted family man.

He is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Eva, daughters Eva and Aggie, son Laszlo, granddaughter Nicole, and great-grandson Aidan and their extended families. He was well respected and loved by all who knew him.

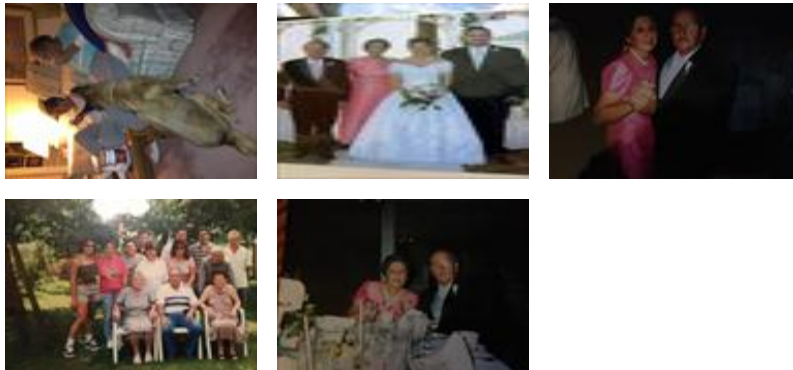

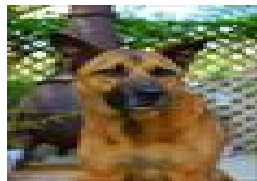
