Many times Arthur worked extra jobs in addition to his full time job to provide for his family and his work ethic and loyalty became a pillar of his character to all that knew him.

Even during retirement Arthur and Terry worked every weekend at local flea markets selling "treasures" which became a passionate hobby for both. After moving to Town Shores, in Gulfport, FL in 1999, they continued this passion
