Arthur Winford Levy II died peacefully at his home in Casselberry, Florida on Monday June 4, 2018.

Born to Arthur Winford Levy Sr. and Beatrice Marie Largie on July 14, 1925 in Halifax Canada.

Within a few years the family moved to Arlington Mass where he spent his youth.

He served his country with pride in the Navy from 1942 through 1962 where he fueled his passion for Naval Aviation and where he received commendations for outstanding performance of duties among others. He is predeceased by sons Arthur and John.

As per his life wishes he was cremated and his cremains will be buried at sea through the Department of the Navy at a later date in accordance with current procedures.

He outlived most all of his mentors, colleagues and friends, but will certainly be missed by those few left behind.
