“ I remember:

Barbara and I had a long history together, A very long one. It all started when she married my cousin Bill Grant, soon after her (future) mother - law, my aunt, introduced them. This predates my involvement, but I heard her tell the story, with relish, many times. Mrs. Grant picked up Frances, Bill's slightly younger sister, from work, one day, from the Diana Shoppes on Orange Ave., Orlando FL, where the 2 girls had after-school clerking jobs. She apparently mentioned to Barbara, "My son is coming home from the Marines, for the weekend" - you oughta come to the house and meet him - and she did just that. It was a classic love story and as soon as Barb graduated from High School, wedding bells rang out over the young couple. I actually got involved a few years later, when Barbara was hospitalized for surgery . I was a student nurse and assigned to take care of her for a number of days.

After this our relationship was sketchy as we were soon both young marrieds, both married to a fellow named Bill, and both working and busily raising a significant number of children. This infrequency of contact changed, however, when her Bill became very ill. After he passed away, the calls and visits continued for a number of years and we swapped stories and recalled her Mother-in-Law's hot yeast rolls with butter dripping, and other memories of days gone by. Shopping trips and lunches shared at Pinero's and Tojay's were inevitable, of course.

I miss her phone calls, now, but am comforted that reunion is coming, when we meet again in our Father's Heavenly Home as Jesus promised in the Gospel of John Chapter 14, verse 2. Special memories for sure. Peggy Powell
