Betty Ann Carson, age 89, succumbed to Alzheimer's Disease on March 26, 2026, at Village on the Green in Longwood, Florida.

She was born on January 7, 1937, in Ravenna, Ohio, the daughter of the late Clarence and Eleanor Baxter, Ravenna, OH.
