We are sad to announce the passing of our sweet mother, Bettye E. Bell, 95 of St.Petersburg. She went home to be with her dear Savior, Jesus Christ, on Sunday,September 12, 2021. She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 54 years, Frank T. Bell.

Bettye's survivors include her son, David, and his wife, Pamela; and Virginia McCrory, her sister and only remaining sibling. There are also nieces and nephews in Florida, Tennessee and Colorado.
