Carl S Engler of Longwood, Florida, went home to be with the Lord on July 12th, 2010. Sadly, this was only two days after his 72nd birthday. Carl was born in Allentown, Pennsylvania, and moved to Central Florida in 1960 after having been stationed here in the Air Force.

He was a pilot and flight instructor at Showalter Aviation, Herndon Airport, for many years in the 1970's. After that he spent 20 years as an Electrical draftsman and engineer, designing the lighting and electrical systems for several well known structures in downtown Orlando. Carl was also an avid model-railroader. His fondness for this activity dates back to the 1940's. He specialized in HO gauge models, and was a member of the Central Florida Railroad Modelers Club where many of his own models and those he worked on are displayed for public enjoyment.

He is survived by his wife, Eloise and 5 children: Joan Foster and husband Jim, Jan Miller and husband Dale, Jennifer Hassel and husband Scott, Keith Engler and wife Julie, and his youngest Judi Frazier. Additionally, Carl has 10 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his sister Catherine and husband Don. As a devoted father and loving husband, he will be dearly missed.
