(Eagle Scout Award) At the age of 15 she left school and went to work as a clerk in a downtown Liverpool office. While there she attended daily noon day Mass, at St Mary's, Liverpool. At the age of 24 she emigrated to Brooklyn , New York. She worked for Barclays Bank in Manhattan, where she met her husband of 44 years. Later Rudy's job with AT&T moved them to Greensboro North Carolina, Cecilia went to work at First Federal Bank there. After retirement they were both very active in St Paul the Apostle RC Church, Greensboro, They helped in the pantry for the homeless, they were also ministers of

Consolation, and Eucharistic Ministers.
