Dibbell, Dr. Charles B. of South Pasadena died April 17, 2009.

Dr. Dibbell was born in Garnett, Kanas.

He attended Loyola College, Baltimore, Maryland, and received his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree from the Ohio State University, Columbus. Dr. Dibbell pursued post-graduate training in canine surgery at John Hopkins University, Baltimore.

He served as 1st Lieutenant, World War II.

Dr. Dibbell moved to St. Petersburg from Baltimore in 1946, when he established the West Coast Animal Hospital , which he directed until his retirement in 1981.

Dr. Dibbell had been a member of the American Veterinary Medical Association, the American Animal Hospital Association, the Florida Veterinary Medical Association, past president of the Pinellas County Veterinary Medical Society, and was a member of Lakewood Country Club, now known as St. Petersburg Country Club. He was a former member of the St. Petersburg Lions Club.

Graveside services will be conducted 2:00 P.M. Thursday April 23, 2009 at Woodlawn Memory Gardens Cemetery, St. Petersburg.
