Christopher Prejean, 51, died too soon on June 13th following a brief hospitalization.

Chris was born in New Orleans, La. on February 14th, 1958 at Oshner Hospital, weighing 11 lbs 10.5 ounces. He was at the time, the biggest baby born there. He was the fourth child and fourth son born in a family of eight children.

He attended Cathedral-Carmel Catholic School in Lafayette, LA, for the grade school years and graduated from Teurlings Catholic High School, also in Lafayette, LA. In 1976.

After receiving a Bachelors of Science Degree at LSU, Chris dedicated his life to public service. That a culture could be measured by its treatment of the poor and disabled was not just an idea for him, it was his way of life.
