



Clarence "Bud" Shaw

July 1, 1927 - November 1, 2009

Clarence "Bud" Shaw, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather (our "Poppy"), age 82, passed away on Sunday, November the 1st 2009, surrounded by his loving family at their home in Casselberry, FL. Bud was born on July 1st, 1927, in Crucible, PA, to William Homer Shaw and Goldie Sappington Shaw (both deceased). He had four brothers and six sisters: He is survived by brother, James Shaw (Punta Gorda, FL).
