Tussing, Clarence L. 97 passed away Dec. 31, 2011 peacefully at home in the loving arms of Wanda, his wife of 67 years. His children were at his side. Mr. Tussing was a professional musician (Violin, Upright Bass) for 45 years. He was also a S/Sgt. in the U.S. Air Force from 1942 to 1946. He was a partner of Tussing Printing in St. Petersburg from 1946 to 1952. He and Wanda co-owned E-Z Print Rubber Stamp Co., from 1952 until their retirement in 1983. He lived in St. Petersburg from 1946 until 2001 when they moved to Sun City Center, Florida. He was an active member of Allendale United Methodist Church in St. Petersburg for many years. Clarence is survived by his wife, Wanda; daughter LeAnn (Bill) Casey, Ruskin, FL and son Gary Tussing, Nashville, TN.; grandson Craig (Yulia) Casey and great grandsons Benjamin and Kyle Casey, Apollo Beach, FL.
