



## Darl Curtis Lipps

Darl Curtis Lipps 70, of Longwood Florida passed away February 7, 2017 from complications of pneumonia. Darl, was born May 21, 1946, in Conneaut, OH, the son of Lester and Mae Lipps of Wayne, OH.

Darl, a 1963 graduate of Pymatuning Valley High School in Andover, OH played basketball 4 years on an outstanding Laker team and ran cross country. From an early age he worked at many local farms.
