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Douglas William MacFarland Marshal, 89 of Altamonte Springs, Florida, passed away peacefully on November 5, 2022 surrounded by family and friends. Doug was born in Perth Amboy, New Jersey where he lived until he relocated to Florida. He worked in the insurance business for many years where he made lifelong friends and mentored many of his employees. Doug was also a motivational speaker which was reflected in the way he lived his life and encouraged positivity in others.
