Edith "Edie" Guerdan (Peck), age 88 of Maitland, Florida, passed away peacefully on August 22, 2024. Edie was born in Avoca, New York on March 29, 1936 to Stanley and Margaret (Conner) Peck. She was raised on the family farm and studied at William Smith College in Geneva, New York where she met her future husband, David "Dave" Guerdan, a student at Hobart College.
