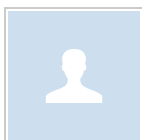

“ I learned of Ed's passing into eternity from a note I received in today's mail from Pastor Bob Hock.

We were all much younger back in 1985, when my husband Greg and I became members of St. John's Lutheran Church.

Just a few months later, on May 25th, 1986, I was broad-sided by another car that had been directed at me head-on, at the intersection of Pine Hills Road and North Lane in Orlando.

I suffered multiple injuries, including 4 fractures to my pelvic bone and one to my right hip.

Ed came to visit me in Brookwood Hospital many times; most notably, (to my memory) 10 days after the wreck, when doctors finally administered a laxative. Dearest Ed was in the room when I finally had a BM...a full ten days after the accident. To say things stunk would be an understatement...and yet, I was astounded by Ed's avoidance of the obvious. He was there to see and support me in my time of need.

Weeks later, no, probably months afterward, when I was finally able to walk again, I attended a Sunday service at St. John.

I'll never forget (indeed, I've shared this story many times) the BEAR-HUG I got from Ed as I entered the church! I hadn't fully appreciated the pain from my broken ribs...suffered in the car wreck months before...until Ed Soistman hugged and welcomed me back to St. John's!!!

Ed Soistman's loving smile and welcoming personality are forever engraved upon my heart.

It is with sincere sympathy that I (finally) join you and your family in grieving at his tragic loss.

I can only console myself now...and hope that you can, too...in God's Promise of joyful reunions in Heaven....when He calls us to Him in our final resting place.

Ed Soistman....you are loved! Thank you for "being Jesus" to me in my life...how precious you are and always will be!!!
