“ I am saddened to hear of Eoghan's passing. I first met Eoghan by phone in 1998, when I was asked to go to Japan to present how to install a Mitsubishi gas turbine. Over the course of a few weeks, Eoghan thought me everything he knew, so that I could be prepared for my meetings. Later that year, Eoghan would mobilise to Japan, and onto Australia for Shanahan Engineering on a new plant installation. Eoghan later moved to Orlando, where we had set up an office in 1999 on Orange Avenue. We secured a role with the former SIEMENS WESTINGHOUSE team, with other Shanahan engineers.
