TOMBROS, EPOMONONDOS (FRED) JAMES, 91, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 23rd, with his two sons Frederick and Theodore by his side. He was born on November 29, 1918 in Hammonton, NJ and was the youngest of four brothers who are deceased.
