SMOAK, FLOYD K, 85, of St. Petersburg, passed away Oct. 13th, 2012 after a brief bout with cancer. He was a career firefighter for the City of St. Petersburg, a home builder, skilled carpenter, and avid outdoorsman after having served in the Army in WWII. Floyd retired as a Lieutenant after service with engine, rescue, and ladder companies. He served his Church for many years, and produced thousands of small toys for children of all ages. His passion for the mission of Christ United Methodist never wavered, having volunteered thousands of hours in various capacities over the course of 60+ years. He inspired a sense of public service in his children and many others in the course of his life. He was often a fixture at charity service centers, and even active disaster recovery locations. He is survived by his wife Kathleen, a son and daughter, and numerous grand and great-grandchildren. Born in Sparr, Florida---he shared a farm life boyhood with his brothers Alfred, Elmer, and Allen and sisters Adelaide, Zora, and Martha Sue.
