



## Francis C Fuoco

August 30, 1927 - July 11, 2023

Frances C Fuoco (Palie) a.k.a. Aunty Fran died peacefully with her 3 children present in the room, at Advent Health Hospice, Altamonte Springs FL at the age of 95.

With so many nieces and nephews when she started the daycare she was known to the children as Aunty Fran.

From the moment she opened her arms to the children, her love became an unbreakable bond that lasted a lifetime. They affectionately called her Aunty, but she was so much more—she was family.

Her love extended beyond bloodlines, she became a haven of warmth and nurturing for lucky children she tended to. She was more than a caregiver; she

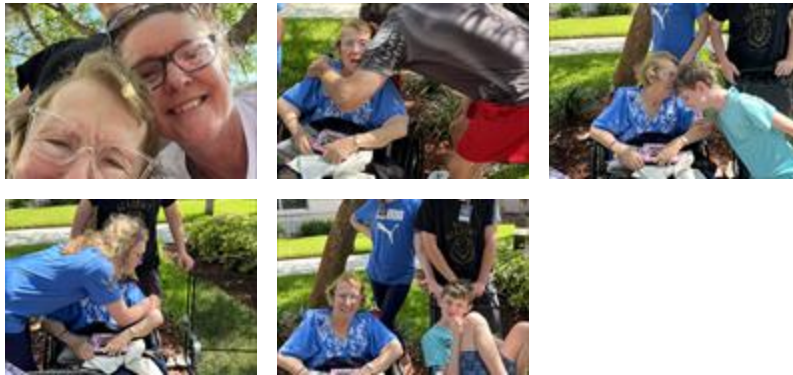
