



Mr. Franklin C. Moore

January 11, 1937 - September 22, 2012

Franklin Curtis Moore, age 75, died on Sept. 22, 2012 from complications of cancer. He was born in Richmond, VA. Frank received a B.S. in Civil Engineering from Virginia Tech and M.S. in Engineering Science from George Washington University. His early career at Atlantic Research in Alexandria, VA involved him in the development of visco-elastic stress analysis of plastic materials used in solid fuel rocket motors.

At the time of his retirement in 1998 from Lockheed Martin, he was Project Manager of research and development contracts developing structures and materials for advanced stealth technology. During this time he was honored as co-inventor of the year for special materials. His 29 years working in Orlando consisted of a broad range of projects and technologies for missiles and electronic systems.

Frank was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Maitland, University Club of Winter Park, and former member of the Winter Park Racquet Club. He was past president of the Central Florida Chapter of the Virginia Tech Alumni Association.

He is survived by his caring wife of 50 years, Janice, son Stephen, daughter-in-law Jane, grandson Jason, daughter Rebecca and her fiancé John Boyer.
