Busch, Fred, 86, of Pinellas Park, FL quietly went to be with his Lord on Sept. 21, 2008. He was born on Christmas Day, 1921 in Clifford, MI to Frederick & Eva Asmus Busch as the older brother to sisters Lydia Busch Jurk, and "little sister" Mary Busch Miller, who resides in Bradenton, FL. Returning from service in WWII, Lydia introduced him to a fellow German-Russian community young lady who, during courtship, led him to a personal faith in Christ. They were married on Sept. 22, 1946 and his faithful wife Emma Miller Busch survives in Pinellas Park, FL. His departure was on the eve of their 62nd anniversary. Retiring from General Motors, they moved from Flint, MI to Florida in 1982, where he transported disabled children at P.A.R.C. Mr. Busch is also survived by his daughter & husband, Diana "Didi" Busch & Phillip Hardley of Upland, IN; son & wives, Fred R. & Susan Busch of Safety Harbor, FL, Alan E. & Sue Busch of Seminole FL, David A. of Pinellas Park, FL; 6 grandchildren & spouses, 4 great-grandchildren, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, generations of cousins, nephews and nieces who "...sorrow not as others which have no hope." 1 Thes. 4:13-14.
