



Gaylee Ann DiMeo

December 7, 1936 - October 24, 2010

DiMeo, Gaylee A., 73, of Jensen Beach, Florida, passed away at Hospice of the Comforter in Altamonte Springs, Florida with her family at her bedside. She was predeceased by her husband, Louie DiMeo and by her sister, Beverly Marino.

She is survived by her nieces, Roxanne Davis-Filippelli, JoEllen Wonsowicz, Samantha Marino and by her nephew, Dominic Marino. She is also survived by three great nieces, one great nephew, one great-great niece and three great-great nephews. She is also survived by her beloved birds.

She was a past president of the American Legion Woman's Auxillary in Jensen Beach, Florida. Her family and friends are shocked by her sudden passing as approximately three weeks ago she went to the emergency room at Martin Memorial Hospital and was released after several hours, the doctors advising her that there was nothing wrong with her. She was attended to at her home for several days by NurseOnCall Home Healthcare. The healthcare worker either failed to notice that there were five days of uneaten food stacked in various stages of decomposition and covered with insects in the kitchen or did not think it unusual. One week after Martin Memorial Hospital released her from the emergency room her niece arrived to find her dehydrated and jaundiced and in such alarming condition that her niece drove her to a hospital in Orlando where her condition was so dire she was immediately admitted. Within a couple days she was transferred to the intensive care unit. It was then determined she had advanced cancer in numerous organs and within

days she passed away.

Her Irish spirit will be missed by us all. There will be a private cremation.

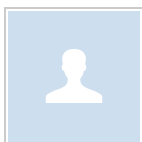
