Dad was born in Petion-Ville, Haiti on Jan 2, 1961. His father, Gerard Cambronne, a respected man of God and servant to the community, was well-loved by all and his mother, Thermacile Cambronne passed away early on. In search of work, Gerard Cambronne left Haiti to provide for the family. In the midst of adolescence, Dad became a leader for his family.

Geno was a positive role model for everyone. Determined, intelligent, kind, humorous, and being wise beyond his years are all qualities that describe the type of man he was. He went by Dja, Mon uncle, Ju, or Geno. Whatever you knew our father by, he encouraged you to want better for yourself and achieve your dreams.
