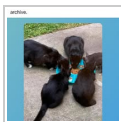

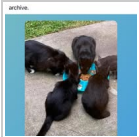

My first memory of George was his first day of work at Florida Hospital. He worked in X-ray and he was assigned to me to show him around the department and go over the equipment with him. Each exam room we went to it was the same response from him “yeah, yeah I already know that” before I could get through the entire review. I asked if he had this same equipment where he came from and he said not exactly, but they’re all basically the same. I told George that if I didn’t show him everything I might get into trouble. He said don’t worry about it; I’ll tell the boss we covered it all and that you did a good job. I would come to find out that this “Know it all from New York tech” was all about shortcuts, but he definitely knew his stuff and always got the job done.

That first irritating day with George turned into “I can’t wait to work with George again” which turned into “What has George done now?”. He was always smiling and laughing (sometimes at someone else’s expense) and boy did he like to joke around. One of his favorite pranks was to KY jelly the earpiece of the phone. He slimed more people than I can recall. He also tormented whoever was in the darkroom with his famous water-filled rubber glove that was coated in KY jelly. The darkroom tech would feel for the contents in the passbox and would inevitably get goo all over their hands. You knew when it happened too, because you could hear GEORGE screamed at the top of their lungs from within the darkroom.

George had a very sweet and sincere side as well. When I was pregnant and stuck working the coordinator’s desk, he always made sure I had food to snack on since it was tough to get away. I also recall having the prettiest flowers in my office each week (but they were not my flowers). George would buy flowers from the hospital gift shop usually on Fridays. He would ask to leave them in my office until he got off work. I knew they were for his special Angie, but I would ask what was the occasion? He would always reply “No occasion, it’s Friday, Angie is my beautiful wife that I love so much



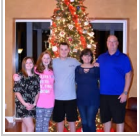
