Gerald was a Gulf War era veteran receiving training as a field paramedic and worked as an EMT. He was also a Irrigation specialist in the Horticulture Industry.

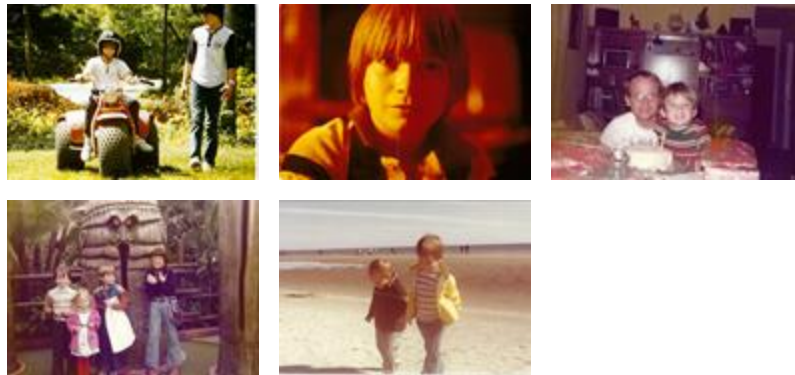
