Gerald "Jerry" L. Crump passed away at his residence in Lake Mary, Florida on Tuesday, August 4, 2020 at the age of 87. He departed this earth peacefully in his sleep to be with the Lord in Heaven.

Jerry was born on January 13, 1933 in Lenoir, North Carolina. He met and fell in love with his wife, Judy, while attending high school in Asheville, North Carolina. After graduating high school, he joined the United States Air Force. Judy and Jerry were married a short time later in Gaffney, South Carolina on January 10, 1953. But most of all he enjoyed spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren. In his last conversation with his daughters he said he wanted more than anything for his family to be together.
