In lieu of flowers, the family requests you 'pay it forward' or contribute to a charity of your choosing in Jerry's memory.

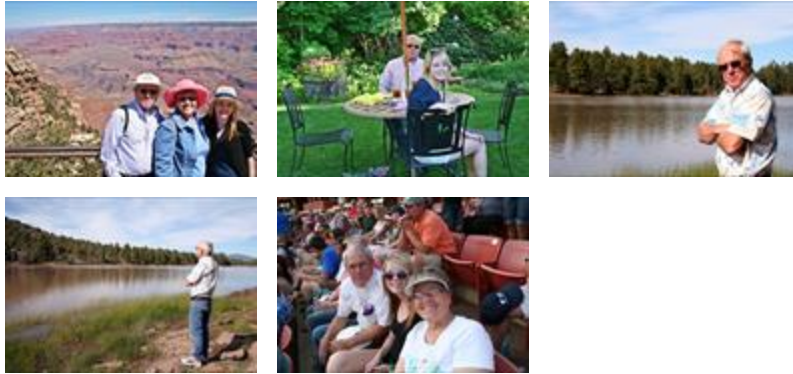

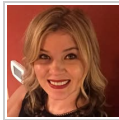
