Herbert L. Barbour, 84, died Friday, August 13, in his home. He was born on November 13, 1925 in Goldsboro, NC to Herbert and Pauline Barbour. He enrolled at Wake Forest University in 1944 but soon thereafter enlisted in the Navy to fight for his country in World War II. He was Honorably Discharged in 1946.
