Homer H. Prentice, 98 of St. Petersburg passed away Monday, October 9, 2017. Homer acquired his strong work ethic growing up on a farm in lower Michigan, learning things on his own. During WWII, he left his work at a machine shop and enlisted in the Army, where he served for four years Stateside and then deployed for 18 months in the European Theater.
