Jack Osborn, 72, of Longwood, Florida, passed away peacefully on August 12, surrounded by his family. Jack, born in Vanzant, Missouri to Richard and Freda Osborn, proudly served in the Army with assignments in Germany and Scotland before moving to Florida and working as a NASA contractor. Jack later owned a pool construction company, and most recently was chief executive officer of Altamonte Springs based Winborn Jet Services. Jack was an early UCF Football booster, helping the program by raising money and interest in the fledging program. He remained a life-long fan of the Knights. Jack is survived by his wife of 46 years, Lorna Osborn, his daughter, Lorna Truett and her husband, Bill Truett, two granddaughters, Lorna and Jamison, a sister, Darlene and a brother, Gary. 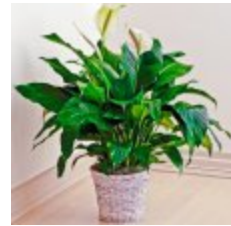
