James Terrance Bagley (Jim), 62, passed away on Feb. 14, 2018 at Florida Hospital from complications of a stroke suffered in mid-January. He was born in Watertown, N.Y. on June 28, 1955 and moved to Orlando with his family when he was five. He attended Lake Silver Elementary, Robert E.
