Eldridge, James W. 84 of Pinellas Park, died Tuesday February 19, 2008 at 7:20 P.M. in Columbus, Indiana.

Mr. Eldridge retired from Swift and Company in Hammond, Indiana in 1970 then from Lever Brothers in Whiting, Indiana in 1989 as a Chemist, where he had worked for 19 years, and was a Union Steward at Lever Brothers.

He was a member of the Church of Christ in Griffith, In. and the Skyview Church of Christ in Pinellas Park, Fl.

He was an Army veteran of WWII serving with the 82nd Airborne-508th Parachute Infantry Company A. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal.
