



James Joseph Mulrennan

May 24, 1932 - July 4, 2015

James (Jim) Joseph Mulrennan passed away on July 4th 2015, after a brief illness. Born May 24, 1932 in Boston, Massachusetts, Jim grew up in Boston and joined the Navy, becoming a veteran of the Korean war.

A graduate of Boston College, he first worked as an accountant for the Government Accounting Office, moving on to various regional and national accounting firms. In 1961, Jim became a Certified Public Accountant and in 1971 started his own firm, James Mulrennan and Company in Londonderry, New Hampshire. He retired from this firm in 2002.

He and his first wife, Lillian (Ratay) of Derry, New Hampshire, had three children – Michael, Brian and James. Lillian died in 1974 and Jim remarried in 1990 to Pauline Tomaselli. She has five children, Kathryn Catalfamo (Frank), Joseph (Debra), Kevin (Becky), Steven, and Gina Maki (Bryan).

Jim was trustee emeritus of Pinkerton Academy in Derry, New Hampshire, former president of two Rotary Clubs and former Treasurer and Director of Fairways Four Condominium Association in Melbourne Florida, where he served for the last 13 years. In addition to his beloved wife Pauline, Jim leaves behind 8 children, 14 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren.
