“ My favorite memory about Javier was when we were kids and played basketball together at the park. Javi was always competitive, and strived to be the best at every task he set out to accomplish. He wanted to be better than me, but for years he couldn't beat me in the game. No matter who was on his team. I used to make fun of him by saying "I was better than he was because I spent all of my free time on the court, while he was locked behind the fence at his house, not allowed to come outside to play".

That made him mad. Mad enough to focus on the game. We would bet on the games. If I lost I would yell he was better than I was. If he lost he would come back tomorrow and try again. Eventually he got really good and beat me to the point I would have to do yell out loud "Javier is better than Stephen". And in all honesty he was. I was there with him when he made his first slam dunk. He was so happy, and so excited that he ran up to me and screamed in my face.... "Yea boy, lets see you do that"! My reply to him simple "I can't".

I was never able to slam dunk, but Javier accomplished it because focused on the game, and in his heart and mind, he wanted to be the best. He was unbeatable from there on out, to the point that I had to retire from the court, because playing against him became a losing battle. I must admit that Javier was the best ball player we had on the court for years thereafter, and our friendship became as close as brothers over the years, but unfortunately, as we grew up, we parted ways.

Javier moved to Central Florida to start a business, I moved to Washington, D.C. to fight for Children's and Family rights before The Supreme Court of the United States. Hearing the news about the accident has caused me to realize that sometime we never really appreciate or know what we have, until we no longer have it. Sometime what we do have in life, and in our friends is priceless in terms of making this life memorable, filled with laughter, and happiness, opposed to something more than just a journey for justice, plight for freedom, or struggle to just make it through

another day.

In my heart and mind, Javier was and will always be one of the good guy's who was take away too early. If I could have nominated three people from our neighborhood, and from our age group who all hung out together to be granted longevity in life, Javier would definitely be one of the three. The other two are Anthony Jon Auther Sims, and Lesley Baller, solely because they are one of the few who struggled through the hardships and challenges we faced as kids, and made it through without being caught in the mess, or addicted to drama.

I will miss you Javi. I hope that we will have an opportunity to see one other when it's my time to go. Until then. I will honor my promise to you, and do everything that I can to protect your family as I always have..

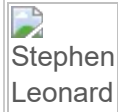
