Jennifer Moon-sun Kim, 77, of Maitland, Florida passed away peacefully in her home on November 26, 2022 due to complications from Alzheimer's disease. She was born on May 3, 1945 in South Korea to Jong-kyu and Ho-choon (Lee) Kim.

Jennifer graduated from Ewha Girls' High School in 1963, Yonsei University with a degree in nursing in 1967 and came to the United States in 1970 to work as a nurse and furthered her education with a MSN from Boston University in 1979. Her nursing career spanned all across the country from New York, Massachusetts, Iowa and finally arrived in Florida in 1986. She worked for 23 years as a school nurse with the Orange County Public Schools system mostly at Colonial High School serving special needs children and retired in 2011.

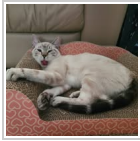

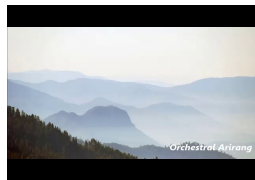

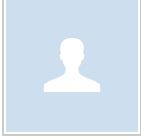
