Jesse Nathaniel Helm, of Longwood, Florida, 30, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 3, 2022.

He was a loving son, grandson, and brother to all. Jesse loved sports, he played pony baseball in his youth at West Seminole, although injuries kept him from playing in high school, he continued to mentor and coach including a girls travel softball team for 3 years.
