John Maloney Cain, a retired prominent Orlando attorney and longtime resident of Winter Park and Maitland, passed away on October 15, 2011 after a long illness. John is survived by his loving wife, Heidi Marie. John was born in Indianapolis, Indiana to Arthur T. and Katherine Korbly Cain on June 23, 1931. He was raised in Madison, Indiana and graduated from Madison High School in 1949. He served in the Adjutant General office while in the U. S. Air Force during the Korean War. John graduated from the University of Florida School of Law in 1960 and began practicing law in Orlando with the Gurney firm usually defending insurance companies. While he was a partner with former Orlando Mayor Bill Frederick, John began practicing family law. He was a board certified family law attorney and was featured in the Orlando magazine as one of the 10 best divorce lawyers in Orlando. John practiced law for 44 years.

John was an avid reader, enjoyed traveling and spending time with his friends. He was one of the kindest and most generous people and he treated everyone with respect and was non judgmental. He accepted everyone for who they were.

John is survived by his daughter and her partner, Andrea and Louise Tozer-Cain of Orlando, FL; son and daughter-in-law, Drs. John M. and Carolyn M.
