



## Reverend Johnnie L. Carroll

Rev. Johnnie Bailey Carroll, age 94, Citrus Springs, formerly of St. Petersburg, FL

died at her residence on Saturday Oct. 4, 2008 under the care of her family and Hospice of Citrus County. Survivors include a daughter Ann Carroll Sitterson of Citrus Springs, FL., two sons, Roy D. Carroll, Rutland FL., and Stephen W. Carroll/Marina Carroll, Treasure Island, FL., brother Paul Bailey of Montgomery, Ala., eight grand children and two great grand children. She was preceded in death by her husband, Rev. Roy W. Carroll, in 1990.

She was born in Geneva County, Ala. on Nov. 17th, 1913. After graduation from Slocomb High School, Slocomb, Ala. she graduated from Southeastern Bible College in 1937 as one of the first graduates of SEBC in New Brocton, Ala.

After graduation, she moved to Georgia and helped establish churches in Sheffield, Ala., Florence, Ala., Cairo, Ga., Blakely, Ga., McDonough, Ga., Colduitt, Ga., Moultrie, Ga., which are still in existence today. She and Rev. Roy Carroll married in 1939. Together they established a church in Georgetown, S.C., and co-pastored two churches in Stockbridge and Tomaston, Ga.

In 1948 they moved to St. Petersburg and established Faith Assembly of God and Calvary Assembly of God in Tarpon Springs. In addition to pastoring the churches they were active in ministering to inmates, nursing homes, hospitals and the home bound. Rev. Johnnie Carroll received a special honor for

recognition of fifty years of dedicated ministry in the fellowship of the Assemblies of God.

After her pastoral years she continued her ministry by phone to shut-ins and others in troubling situations. Memorials requested to Hospice of Citrus Co. PO Box 641270, Beverly Hills, Fl. 34464.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home Thursday, Oct. 9 from 1 P.M. until service time at 2 P.M. Internment will follow at the Memorial Park Cemetery.
