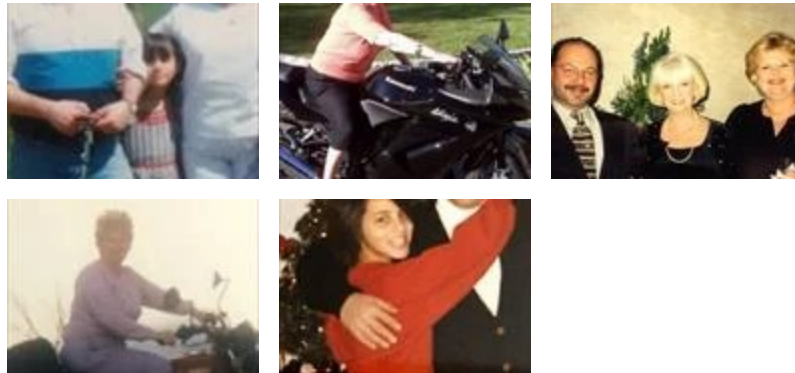

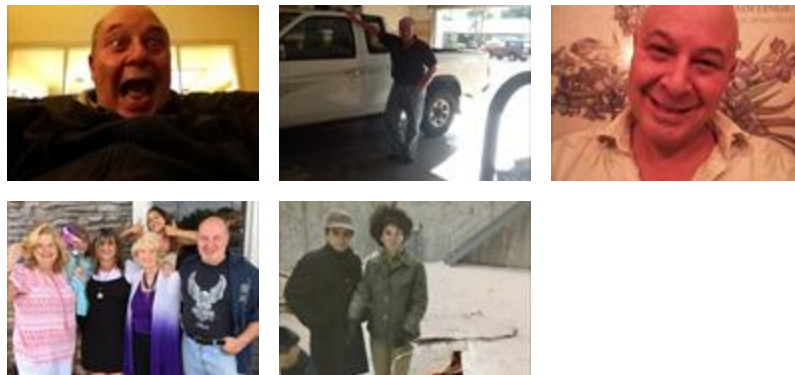

I was very happy that i reconnected with Jorge during the past year, when he helped me pick out an acoustic guitar to help with my objective to learn to play guitar during Covid. That was interestingly apropos as it was Jorge that traveled to NYC with me back in 1999, as my guitar advisor, helping me pick out the exact Eric Clapton Creamy (white) Stratocaster that i purchased at the Christie's Auction. And even more recently, within the last month or so, Jorge came over my house and jammed on guitar and we had dinner together. Hearing Jorge playing the Clapton Strat was a super treat. Jorge had essentially STOPPED playing guitar for a number of years and recently (with some encouragement from me) started playing again. Of course, despite being super rusty and out of practice, Jorge's sweet and tasty guitar licks put my Covid guitar to shame. Teacher Jorge said: Just do THIS....but i could not follow. Jorge had natural musical talent to the core playing bass and guitar and doing it with apparent ease. How did he do that? Jorge introduced me to my saxophone professor Harry Hall, and when Harry passed in 2014, Jorge encouraged me to come to Harry's celebration of life at the Hideaway Bar and play with all of the musician friends of Harry's including Jorge. I really appreciated Jorge for that. I also appreciated Jorge for making sure i went to the best shows at Wills Pub, like Sam Rivers. Jorge was a gentleman and a scholar in music, in technology and in politics. Of course the most FUN parts was Jorge making FUN and joking about ANY of those subjects. Jorge found ironic humor in many of life's idiosyncrasies which reflected his intelligence and his fondness for calling BS. The best part was his actual LAUGH: Hearty, genuine and on point.
