



## Jose Raul Figueroa

December 20, 1942 - August 3, 2020

Jose Raul Figueroa passed away at the age of 77 years old, at the Life Care Center in Altamonte.

Joe was preceded in death by his father Concepcion Figueroa, his brother Miquel Figueroa and in March of this year his mother, Virginia Rodriguez Figueroa.

Joe's strength was tested, he overcame health issues, Appendicitis and 5 surgeries in the last 2 years. He passed away unexpectedly on Monday August 3rd, 2020 at 3:30pm.

Joe's life was a journey of many ups and downs, but he always faced them with a positive attitude. He always had a smile or encouraging word. He truly loved people. He was the life of the party, the one who always made everyone feel special. A true storyteller, but a man who could not tolerate injustice to others. He never thought twice about helping those in need... people were important to him.
