As we became adults, we had separate lives but always knew the other was there. It wouldn't matter if we hadn't seen each other or spoken to each other in a while - if I needed him, there he was - ready to do whatever, whenever and wherever. I loved hearing him tell our stories, he brought them back as though they had just happened. I loved knowing that he was always there. I loved knowing the good man he had become.
