



Joseph "Joe" Peter Mirisola

Joseph "Joe" Peter Mirisola died unexpectedly in Winter Park, FL at the age of 62. He was born in South Boston, Massachusetts to Joseph Peter Mirisola & Claire Mirisola on August 8, 1961. At a young age, his family moved to Orlando, FL where he remained for the rest of his life.

You typically would find him in the kitchen cooking breakfast, watching cartoons, humming songs to himself, or fussing over his plants. He will be remembered for his unconditional love, vibrant wardrobe, playful spirit, and zest for life.
