Kathlyn "Lindy" Gilmore Conrad, 64 of Orlando, Florida passed away Saturday, May 7, 2011. Born to John Madison Gilmore and Thelma Sarah Cupper on March 9, 1947 in Spartanburg, South Carolina; Lindy was raised in Charleston, South Carolina. She attended St John's Catholic School and Bishop England High School as Mary Kathlyn Gilmore. In September 1968, she married Edgar Haynes Conrad and although they moved several times while he served in the military, the couple eventually settled in the Central Florida area to raise their family.

Lindy returned to school after many years as a mother and homemaker. In 1995 she finished her Bachelor's Degree in computer science and joined the work force. During her career she worked for several companies as a computer software systems analyst. Most recently she enjoyed the challenge of programming for military simulators. Her greatest personal achievement was the completion of her education and her successful career was a source of pride.
