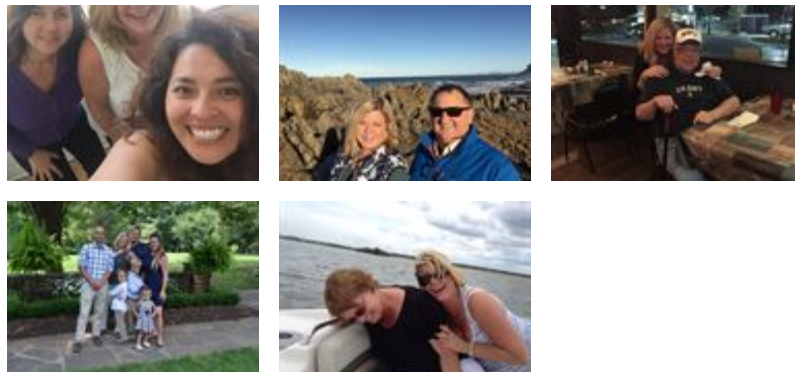

I cannot express into words how her passing has left me empty. A

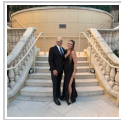
part of me is lost, my deepest confidante and beloved sister is gone to the heavens. I know she wants us to remember the joy, fun, warmth and love that we all shared with her.
